CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Riverwood Christadelphians are using this facility, under the conditions required by the NSW Government, as a “Place of public worship”. Riverwood Christadelphians are registered as a COVID Safe Business under the current NSW Government restrictions, updated 29th March, 2021.

For the wellbeing of our members and community please ensure you adhere strictly to the following conditions of entry.

- **PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND IF:**

- you are feeling unwell
- you have been in contact with a suspected or confirmed case of Covid-19 in the last 14 days.
- you have visited a listed hotspot or venue with a confirmed case of Covid-19

- Attendance is by pre-registration via the Ecclesial App or invitation and you will be checked off a roll on arrival. If you are not pre-registered, you will be asked to register via QR code.
- Temperature checks may be conducted upon entry.
- Current NSW restrictions on numbers apply at this premises. If you have not registered and the event is full, you will be asked to leave.
- Please sanitise your hands before entry and after touching any surfaces in particular in bathroom and/or kitchen areas.
- Please take your seats quickly and avoid mingling at the entry and in the hall after the event.
- Please follow all directional signage.
- Physical distancing is to be observed. 1.5m between members who are not from the same household. This includes no greetings with a hug, hand-shake or kiss.
 - *When attending multi-age gatherings, children and teenagers must observe the same 1.5m distancing as the adult members unless they are members of the same household.*
 - *Children and teenagers attending a youth event are not required to socially distance or wear masks, however adults must maintain 1.5m from children where possible. Teachers and presenters are not required to wear masks.*
