Conditions of Entry

1. PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND IF:
 - a) you are feeling unwell
 - b) you have been in contact with a suspected or confirmed case of Covid-19 in the last 14 days.
 - c) you have visited a venue with a confirmed case of Covid-19 – as per updates on the NSW Health website.
 - d) you have a member of your household waiting for the results of a COVID-19 test.
2. Attendees will be marked off the roll by the Sunday School Secretary
3. Sanitise your hands before entry.
4. Practice good personal hygiene such as:
 - a) Washing hands regularly.
 - b) Practice of good cough and sneeze etiquette.
 - c) Use of hand sanitiser provided.
 - d) Avoid touching your face - nose, eyes and mouth, where possible.
5. The kitchen area is out of bounds when not in use for Sunday School.
6. Parents are to drop children off at the gate and not to mingle at the entrance to the hall.
7. If you are not staying for the memorial meeting, please pick up your children before 10.30am.
8. Do not share phones, bibles, books, pens or pencils.
9. Follow all directional signage and instructions from your Sunday School teachers.

NOTE:

As per the Riverwood Covid-19 Safety Plan, Education programs should be conducted in accordance with the NSW Government guidelines on Schools and Childcare. Students do not need to follow strict adult physical distancing guidelines but should follow good hygiene practices. Teachers should continue to maintain 1.5m physical distancing from students where practical. Masks are not mandatory at Sunday School for students or teachers, however all need to revert to social distancing and mandatory mask wearing for the mixed age memorial meeting once Sunday School concludes at 10.30am.
